OUR HISTORY

Lock One Community Arts (LOCA), a non-profit organization, was formed in 2001 by three couples with the intent of bringing live professional stage performances to the West Central Ohio region. This group exists through the support of faithful sponsors, season pass holders, ticket sales and generous contributions from businesses and friends. All activity is governed by an all-volunteer board composed of a dedicated group of local individuals who generously give their time and talents. This support of Lock One is vital to ensure that high quality artistry continues to be provided in our local area.

PINWHEEL PRODUCTIONS

LOCA is particularly proud of its educational branch called Pinwheel Productions. Through this venture, specially selected live performances are provided at no cost to approximately 1,400 kindergarten through eighth grade students from ten area schools. This is achieved through the generosity of local sponsors. Each year, on a rotating schedule, groups of K-2, 3-5, 6-8 grades are invited to the James F. Dicke Auditorium to experience a live, curriculum appropriate, and educational show. All performances are offered in close cooperation with the invited schools' administration.

Each year, LOCA provides one \$500 Scott Kuenning Music Scholarship Award to a New Bremen High School Senior who plans to continue to include music in his/her life.

This scholarship was established as a way to honor the life of Daniel Keyes, a founding member of Lock One Community Arts. Dan shared the arts with the community as a performer, volunteer, set designer, writer, and passionate teacher. He was a founding member of Lock One Community Arts and served on the board as Technical Director for 15 years. He also directed the New Bremen High School Drama Club for many years. He wrote several plays, five of which were presented by the Drama Club, and two screenplays.

Each year, LOCA provides one \$500 Dan Keyes Drama Scholarship Award to a graduating High School Senior who plans to continue with drama education and/or drama performance, and will be graduating from one of the following local schools: New Bremen, Minster, Maria Stein, Ft Loramie, New Knoxville, Anna, St Henry, Botkins, Jackson Center, Coldwater, Hardin-Houston, St Marys, and Celina.
